This course explores the entangled relationships between nature, infrastructure, and landscape, examining how human and non-human actors both shape and are shaped by the spaces they inhabit. Adopting a multidisciplinary and trans-scalar approach that integrates spatial, micro-social, and historical lenses, the course engages with key concepts such as modernization, capitalocene, imperial and colonial formations and heterarchical & hierarchical systems embedded in infrastructural landscapes.
