Adopting a multidisciplinary and trans-scalar approach that integrates spatial, micro-social, and historical lenses, the course engages with key concepts such as modernization, capitalocene, imperial and colonial formations and heterarchical & hierarchical systems embedded in infrastructural landscapes.
